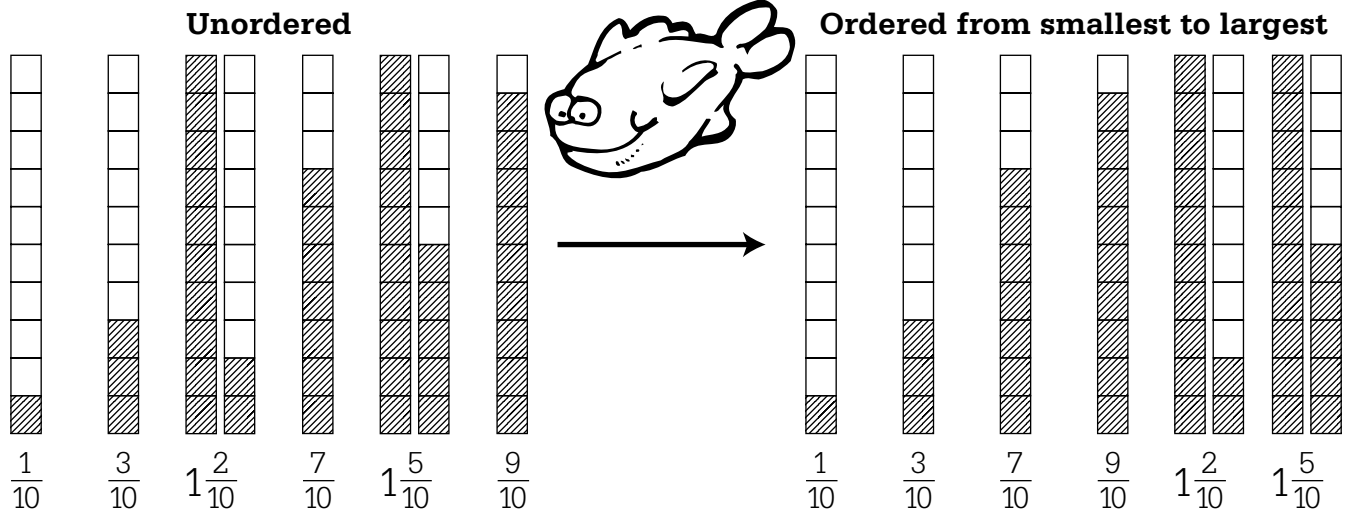


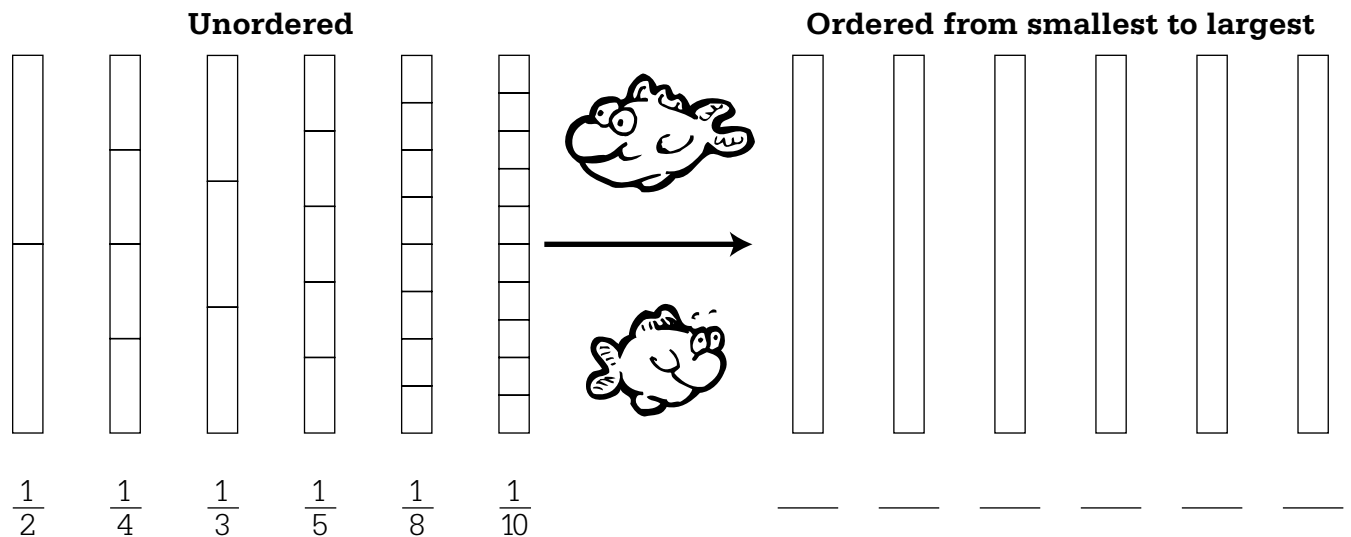
Ordering fractions (1)
